ORDER ON CONSENT MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING

May 14, 2002

BANKS, CHAIRPERSON. On March 20, 2002, the Commission's staff scheduled this appeal for hearing on June 6, 2002. On May 14, 2002, the parties, through counsel filed a consent motion for continuance of the hearing. Pursuant to 14 DCMR 3815.1, parties requesting a continuance must show good cause and file the motion at least five days before the event to be continued. The Housing Provider stated good cause by explaining a prior commitment conflicted with the date of the scheduled hearing. The motion for continuance was filed more than five days before the scheduled hearing. The parties agreed to June 10, 2002, at 2 p.m. as the hearing date, after consultation with the Commission's staff and verification that the date was available. Accordingly, the Commission grants the motion for continuance, and the new hearing date is June 10, 2002 at 2 p.m. in the Commission at 941 North Capitol Street, N.E., Suite 9200, Washington, D.C. 20002.


