ORDER ON MOTION FOR SPECIAL APPEARANCE

BANKS, CHAIRPERSON. Rebecca Lindhurst, counsel for the Sherry Blount, Tenant/Appellant, appeared at the Commission's hearing on June 13, 2002. Neither Thomas John nor Anna John appeared as Housing Provider/Appellant. As a preliminary matter, Attorney Lindhurst requested permission in a written motion for special appearance before the Commission, because she is a member of the New York bar and is waiting for approval of her application for admission to the bar of the District of Columbia. The Commission granted her appearance at the hearing pursuant to 14 DCMR § 3812.4(b) (1991). However, the written motion did not have a certificate of service to the Housing Providers. After the hearing, the Commission issued an order on June 14, 2002, requiring Attorney Lindhurst to file another motion with a certificate of service to the Housing Providers. The second motion for special appearance was filed on June 21, 2002. No opposition was received from the Housing Providers. Accordingly, the motion is GRANTED.


