ORDER FOR COMPLIANCE WITH APPEAL RULES

September 4, 2002

BANKS, CHAIRPERSON. On July 30, 2002, the Commission issued an order requiring Juanita Coleman, the Tenant, to comply with the Commission's rules related to notices of appeal. The Commission's order allowed the Tenant ten (10) days to comply with the appeal rules. On July 30, 2002, the Commission mailed to the parties its order by priority mail with confirmation of delivery. The Commission confirmed delivery of its order to the Tenant by accessing the Track and Confirm web site of the United States Postal Service (USPS), which stated: "Your item was delivered at 10:33 am [sic] on August 01, 2002 in Washington, D.C. 20032." The Commission's record contains a copy of the document confirming delivery on the USPS web site. More than ten (10) days expired from the date, July 30, 2002, on the Commission's order, and the Tenant has not filed the information necessary for the appeal to be in compliance with the Commission's

rules as stated in its order. Accordingly, the Tenant's appeal is dismissed. Cf. Harrell v. Hous. Opportunity for Women, TP 24,954 (RHC Nov. 24, 2000) (where the Commission dismissed the appeal due to the failure of the Tenant to comply with its appeal rules).


