
**ORDER ENLARGING TIME TO ISSUE ORDER ON MOTION FOR  
RECONSIDERATION.**

**PER CURIAM.** On June 25, 2004, Kathy Daniel, Housing Provider, filed a motion for reconsideration of the Commission's decision and order issued on June 18, 2004. That decision and order remanded Tenant Petition (TP) 27,665 to the Rent Administrator and directed the Rent Administrator to calculate and order a trebled rent refund to the tenant. The Commission's rules require a responsive order to the motion for reconsideration, that grants, denies or enlarges the time for later disposition of the

motion, within fifteen (15) days. 14 DCMR § 3823.3 (1991)<sup>1</sup>. Accordingly, due to a backlog of matters pending before the Commission, the Commission enlarges the time to respond to the motion for reconsideration to August 20, 2004.
