YOUNG, COMMISSIONER. On May 17, 2006, the Commission issued a decision and order in the above-captioned appeal. On June 1, 2006, the housing provider filed a motion for reconsideration of the Commission decision. The Commission's rule on reconsideration provides, "[w]ithin fifteen (15) days of filing of the motion, the Commission shall grant the motion, deny the motion or enlarge the time for later disposition of the motion." 14 DCMR § 3823.3 (2004). Due to the Commission's schedule additional time to respond to the housing provider's motion for reconsideration is required. Accordingly, the Commission enlarged the time for issuing the order on the motion for reconsideration to July 14, 2006.

SO ORDERED.


