

**ORDER ENLARGING THE TIME TO RESPOND TO THE TENANT'S MOTION
FOR RECONSIDERATION**

YOUNG, COMMISSIONER. On July 18, 2002, Benoit Brookens, the tenant representative, filed a motion for reconsideration of the Commission's Order on Motion to Reissue Commission's September 28, 2001 Decision issued on July 2, 2002. The Commission's rule on reconsideration provides, "[w]ithin fifteen (15) days of filing of the motion, the Commission shall grant the motion, deny the motion or enlarge the time for later disposition of the motion." 14 DCMR 3823.3. Due to the Commission's schedule additional time to respond to the tenants' motion is required. Accordingly, the Commission enlarged the time for issuing the order on the motion for reconsideration to September 3, 2002.


